

### OKLAHOMA CITY UNIVERSITY 2022 SUMMER BASS CAMP WANDA L. BASS MUSIC CENTER

The 28th Annual Oklahoma City University Summer Bass Camp is a unique and fun opportunity for high school (9th to 12th) college-age bass students and orchestra teachers.



Since Bass Camp will focus

only on the string bass, the in person,

week-long program will offer intensive training for the serious bass student. Every aspect of the bass, and bass playing, will be discussed including solos, ensembles, jazz, orchestra, teaching, maintenance, vibrato, and shifting. String teachers wanting additional experience on the bass are invited to participate. Students attending Bass Camp are supervised.

### ADMISSION INFORMATION

Because of COVID restrictions, admission to the 2022 Bass Camp is limited. Students will be selected by application and vacancies will be filled as applications are received and reviewed. **Applications need to be received no later than June 10, 2022**.

### APPLICATION INFORMATION

The following is required for admission to Bass Camp:

- 1.Complete and return the attached 2022 BASS CAMP APPLICATION form.
- 2.A signature from the student's school orchestra director/teacher. For new students the signature will serve as a recommendation.
- 3. Submit check for payment. Make checks payable to OCU Music (memo line: Bass Camp). Fees may be made in installments, with full payment required by July 1st. When making payments, a \$50 non-refundable deposit must accompany the application form in order to reserve a roster spot. To pay by credit card, please contact Susan Tate at the OCU Wanda L. Bass School of Music at 405-208-5316. Upon receipt of the application and fee a camp information packet will be sent.

### COST

The total cost for the Summer Bass Camp is \$480.00 This cost includes lodging, meals, incidental fees, Bass Camp t-shirt, and tuition. All Camp fees are due by July 1, 2022. Questions concerning payments may be sent to pjschimek@cox.net.

A concert of bass music including the mass bass orchestra will be held in the Atrium of the Wanda L. Bass Music Center on the campus of Oklahoma City University. Admission is free and family and friends are invited to attended, however COVID protocols may be in effect. ### Camp Director

Dr. John Schimek is the 2022 Summer Bass Camp Director and is Professor of Double Bass and Chair of the String Program at Oklahoma City University. An active clinician, he has worked with bass students and orchestras in 40 states as well as in China, Europe, and South America. An award-winning teacher, he is a recipient of the OK-ASTA Teacher of the Year Award and the OCU Outstanding Music Faculty Award. His articles are published in several journals including Bass World and American String Teacher. His students have been selected to participate in many All-Region and All-State orchestras. He is the President of the International Society of Bassists. Assisting Dr. Schimek will be professional performers and teachers from around the country as well as students from Oklahoma City University

### **CAMP LOCATION**

The Wanda L. Bass Music Center is located on the campus of Oklahoma City University. Just minutes away from the state capital, OCU is easily accessible from I-35 or I-40. The dormitories are air-conditioned and adult supervised. All meals will be served on campus Those attending from out-of-state may consider making airline arrangements arriving at Will Rogers International Airport in Oklahoma City.
